1 AN ACT concerning

2 **School Bus ~~Purchasing~~ Transition – Zero-Emission Vehicle ~~Requirement~~**
3 **Vehicles – Grant Program and Fund**

4 FOR the purpose of ~~requiring, beginning on a certain date, that each school bus purchased~~
5 ~~by a county board of education be a zero-emission vehicle; requiring, beginning on a~~
6 ~~certain date, that each school bus purchased by a certain person for use under a~~
7 ~~certain contract with a county board be a zero-emission vehicle; defining a certain~~
8 ~~term; and generally relating to school bus purchases~~ requiring the Department of
9 the Environment and the Department of Transportation to jointly provide technical
10 assistance to certain entities on certain matters; establishing the Zero-Emission
11 Vehicle School Bus Transition Grant Program; providing for the purpose of the
12 Program; requiring the Department of the Environment, in consultation with the
13 State Department of Education, to implement and administer the Program;
14 providing for the funding of the Program; authorizing the Department of the
15 Environment to adopt certain regulations; establishing the Zero-Emission Vehicle
16 School Bus Transition Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of
17 the Fund; requiring the Department of the Environment, in consultation with the
18 State Department of Education, to administer the Fund; requiring the State
19 Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying
20 the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used;
21 requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; exempting the
22 Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest earnings on State money to
23 accrue to the General Fund of the State; defining certain terms; and generally
24 relating to transitioning to school buses that are zero-emission vehicles.

16 SHALL PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND
17 ENTITIES THAT CONTRACT WITH COUNTY BOARDS TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION
18 SERVICES FOR TRANSITIONING TO THE USE OF SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE
19 ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

21 (A) THERE IS A ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE SCHOOL BUS TRANSITION
22 GRANT PROGRAM IN THE STATE.

23 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO COUNTY
24 BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND ENTITIES THAT CONTRACT WITH COUNTY BOARDS TO
25 PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO:

26 (1) PURCHASE SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES;

27 (2) INSTALL ELECTRIC VEHICLE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR CHARGING
28 SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES;

29 (3) ENGAGE IN PLANNING FOR A TRANSITION TO USING SCHOOL
30 BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES; AND

1 **(4) FUND PILOT PROGRAMS TO EXPERIMENT WITH A TRANSITION TO**
2 **SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES.**

3 **(C) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT**
4 **OF EDUCATION, SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.**

5 **(D) (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES ANY FUNDS AS A RESULT OF A**
6 **LEGAL SETTLEMENT THAT ARE EARMARKED FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSITIONING**
7 **TO SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES, THE FUNDS SHALL BE**
8 **MADE AVAILABLE TO AWARD GRANTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.**

18 **(A) THERE IS A ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE SCHOOL BUS TRANSITION**
19 **FUND.**

20 **(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE**
21 **PROGRAM.**

22 **(C) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT**
23 **OF EDUCATION, SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.**

24 **(D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT**
25 **SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

26 **(2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,**
27 **AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.**

28 **(E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:**

29 **(1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;**

1 **(2) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND;**

2 **(3) DONATIONS;**

3 **(4) MONEY DERIVED FROM LEGAL SETTLEMENTS EARMARKED FOR**
4 **THE PURPOSE OF TRANSITIONING TO SCHOOL BUSES THAT ARE ZERO-EMISSION**
5 **VEHICLES; AND**

6 **(5) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR**
7 **THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.**

8 **(F) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE PROGRAM.**

9 **(G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND**
10 **IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.**

11 **(2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO**
12 **THE FUND.**

13 **(H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE**
14 **WITH THE STATE BUDGET.**

15 **(I) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR THE PROGRAM IS**
16 **SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF FUNDING THAT**
17 **OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE PROGRAM.**

20 **(a) (2) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and unless**
21 **inconsistent with a federal law, grant agreement, or other federal requirement or with the**
22 **terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated by the**
23 **State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise entitled to**
24 **receive interest earnings, as accounted for by the Comptroller, shall accrue to the General**
25 **Fund of the State.**

26 **(ii) The provisions of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph do not apply**
27 **to the following funds:**

28 **112. the Pretrial Services Program Grant Fund; [and]**

29 **113. the Veteran Employment and Transition Success Fund;**

114. THE ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE SCHOOL BUS TRANSITION FUND.

Article – Transportation

23-206.4.

(a) In this section, “zero-emission vehicle” means any vehicle that:

(1) Is determined by the Secretary to be of a type that does not produce any tailpipe or evaporative emissions; and

(2) Has not been altered from the manufacturer’s original specifications.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
