A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class D Beer, Wine, and Liquor License**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain prohibition on the issuance of a Class D beer, wine,
4 and liquor license in Carroll County; establishing a Class D beer, wine, and liquor
5 license in Carroll County; authorizing the Board to issue the license to a holder of a
6 manufacturer's license; providing that the license authorizes the sale of beer, wine,
7 and liquor under certain circumstances; prohibiting the license from being issued for
8 a drugstore; providing for an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic
9 beverages licenses in Carroll County.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 A Class D beer, wine, and liquor license may not be issued in the county.]

6 **16–906.**7 **(A) THERE IS A CLASS D BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.**8 **(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF A**
9 **MANUFACTURER’S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER TITLE 2, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.**10 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE SALE:**11 **(1) FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION, OF ANY BEER, WINE, OR**
12 **LIQUOR; AND**13 **(2) FOR OFF–PREMISES CONSUMPTION, ONLY OF THE BEER, WINE, OR**
14 **LIQUOR THAT IS MANUFACTURED ON THE PREMISES.**15 **(D) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED FOR USE BY A DRUGSTORE.**16 **(E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.**17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
18 1, 2019.
