## Agriculture - Nuisance Insects

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to implement, under certain 4 circumstances, a program to control or eliminate nuisance insects in the State; 5 authorizing the Secretary to carry out a certain project to control or eliminate 6 nuisance insects if the county or municipality in which the nuisance insects are 7 located agrees to pay a certain portion of certain costs; establishing the Nuisance 8 Insects Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; requiring the Secretary to remit certain 9 payments to the Comptroller for deposit to the Fund; requiring the Secretary or the 10 Secretary's designee to administer the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; 11 specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used; repealing certain provisions 12 of law relating to black fly management and control; authorizing the Secretary to adopt certain regulations; stating a certain finding of the General Assembly; defining 13 certain terms; and generally relating to controlling or eliminating nuisance insects 14 15 in the State.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 6 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 7 INDICATED.
- 8 (B) "FUND" MEANS THE NUISANCE INSECTS FUND.
- 9 (C) (1) "NUISANCE INSECT" MEANS AN INSECT THAT IS DETERMINED BY 10 THE SECRETARY TO PESTER OR ANNOY ONLY HUMANS.

- 2 (a) The General Assembly finds that the proliferation of certain species of the group Simulium jenningsi, commonly known as black flies, are a public and common nuisance on land and waters used for recreation, employment, and tourism.
- 5 (b) It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Department, in conjunction 6 with the Department of Agriculture and the University of Maryland's Department of 7 Entomology, significantly reduce the population of black flies in the State.]
- 8 [8–2202.
- Subject to funding made available to the Department and the Department of Agriculture to implement the provisions of this subtitle, the Department may, in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture, implement a program to control the spread of black flies in the State.]
- 13 **[**8–2203.
- 14 (a) The program shall be implemented initially in Washington County on:
- 15 (1) State-owned property;
- 16 (2) Property owned by a local government with consent of the local 17 government; and
- 18 (3) Private property with consent of the property owner.
- 19 (b) The Department, in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture and the 20 University of Maryland's Department of Entomology, may:
- 21 (1) Treat the property with an aerial spraying or backpack spraying of 22 Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis;
- 23 (2) Conduct field studies to determine the need for, location, and timing of 24 spraying;
- 25 (3) Schedule spraying when the conditions are optimal for ingestion by the 26 black flies:
- 27 (4) Notify appropriate persons of the date and location of an upcoming 28 spraying;
- 29 (5) Review the effectiveness of the spraying; and
- 30 (6) Conduct biomonitoring of aquatic macroinvertebrates and fish in

- 1 selected streams to ensure there is no impact on the environment.]

- 3 The Department and the Department of Agriculture may accept, use, or expend any
- 4 aid, gift, or grant made available from any private or public source to implement the
- 5 provisions of this subtitle.

- 8 regulations to implement the provisions of this subtitle.]
