1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 Women Veterans Day

- 3 FOR the purpose of designating March 13 as Women Veterans Day.
- WHEREAS, Maryland is home to more than 51,000 women veterans, representing approximately 13% of Maryland's veteran population a larger percentage than the 9% of women veterans of the United States veteran population; and
- WHEREAS, Women veterans are unique in their circumstances and needs, often tending to be younger, and more racially and ethnically diverse in comparison to their male counterparts; and
- WHEREAS, Women veterans are less likely to be married, more likely to be divorced, more likely to bear child care responsibilities, and five times more likely to be in a dual service member marriage than their male counterparts; and
- WHEREAS, Women veterans are less likely to have a family support system and often shoulder greater economic stress than their male counterparts; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the General Assembly of Maryland designates March 13 as Women Veterans Day; and be it further
