# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Criminal Law – Computer–Aided Firearm Fabrication – Prohibitions

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using a certain computer-aided fabrication 4 device to manufacture a firearm; prohibiting a person from possessing, selling,  $\mathbf{5}$ offering to sell, transferring, purchasing, or receiving a firearm manufactured using 6 a certain computer-aided fabrication device; prohibiting a person from possessing and intentionally retaining, or distributing, transmitting, publishing, selling, 7 8 offering to sell, transferring, or purchasing a certain computer control language, 9 computer program, computer software, or computer database; establishing certain 10 penalties; establishing certain exceptions to the prohibitions established under this 11 Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to computer-aided fabrication of 12firearms.

"Computer database" means a representation of information, 1 (6) $\mathbf{2}$ knowledge, facts, concepts, or instructions that: 3 (i) is intended for use in a computer, computer system, or computer network: and 4  $\mathbf{5}$ (ii) 1. is being prepared or has been prepared in a formalized 6 manner; or  $\overline{7}$ 2.is being produced or has been produced by a computer. 8 computer system, or computer network. 9 "Computer program" means an ordered set of instructions or (8)10 statements that may interact with related data and, when executed in a computer system, 11 causes a computer to perform specified functions. 12(10)"Computer software" means a computer program, instruction, procedure, or associated document regarding the operation of a computer system. 13"Computer system" means one or more connected or unconnected 14(11)15computers, peripheral devices, computer software, data, or computer programs. 16SECTION 2.
