1 AN ACT concerning

State Grants and Contracts – Reimbursement of Nonprofit Indirect Costs – Application

FOR the purpose of applying a certain provision of law related to the reimbursement of
indirect costs incurred by certain nonprofit organizations to certain grants and
contracts; providing that a certain provision of law does not require the
reimbursement of indirect costs incurred under certain grants and contracts during
any fiscal year that began before a certain date; altering a certain definition; making
a stylistic change; and generally relating to the reimbursement of indirect costs

20 [(c) This section applies whether or not the funds awarded through the grant or 21 contract are transferred directly by the State or through a third party to the nonprofit 22 organization.]
