7	(i) for indirect costs under a direct federal award; or
8 9	(ii) from a nonfederal entity based on the cost principles in Subpart E of OMB Uniform Guidance; or
10 11 12	(2) if the nonprofit organization has not negotiated and received an indirect cost rate described in item (1) of this subsection, at a rate of at least 10% of the costs that would be considered modified total direct costs under OMB Uniform Guidance.
