9	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
10	(b) "Live poultry market" means any facility OR LOCATION where [live poultry is gathered to be slaughtered and sold on site] POULTRY:

4	(2) IS SLAUGHTERED AND SOLD ON-SITE.
15	(c) "Poultry" means any living domesticated bird OR ITS HATCHING EGGS.
16 17 18	(d) "Poultry dealer" means a person who [is in the business of trading, selling, transporting, or moving poultry between a production facility and a live poultry market] ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OF BUYING, SELLING, EXCHANGING, OR TRANSPORTING POULTRY BETWEEN A PRODUCTION FACILITY AND A LIVE POULTRY MARKET.
20 21	(e) "Production facility" means the facility or farm that is the origin of poultry offered for sale at a live poultry market.

23 24 25	(a) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY THE SECRETARY, EACH live poultry market operator, production facility operator, and poultry dealer shall obtain an annual license from the Secretary.
