- FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law providing that the payment of 4 assessments to the Uninsured Employers' Fund by employers and insurers is 5 suspended when the amount of the Fund equals at least a certain amount; repealing 6 7 the requirement that the Director of the Fund notify self-insured employers and 8 insurers of the suspension of the payment of assessments; repealing the requirement 9 that the payment of assessments resume under certain circumstances; repealing the requirement that the Director of the Fund notify self-insured employers and 10 insurers of the resumption of the payment of certain assessments; making a 11 conforming change; and generally relating to the assessments paid to requiring the 12 Executive Director of the Uninsured Employers' Fund to report to certain 13 14 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the Uninsured Employers' Fund. 15
