- 2 Uninsured Employers' Fund Liability for Insolvent Self-Insured Employers –
- FOR the purpose of limiting the liability of the Uninsured Employers' Fund to pay the outstanding obligations of insolvent self-insured employers to claims that have been found compensable by the Workers' Compensation Commission as of the date of insolvency; prohibiting the Fund from being required to pay more than a certain amount per claim under a certain provision of this Act; and generally relating to the liability of the Uninsured Employers' Fund for insolvent self-insured employers.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 19 (g) (1) [If] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF an
- 20 employer who self-insures under this section becomes insolvent, the Uninsured Employers'
- 21 Fund shall pay the outstanding obligations of the employer for compensation ONLY ON A
- 22 $\,$ Claim that has been found compensable by the Commission as of the date

- 1 (2) THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO PAY MORE THAN \$100,000 PER CLAIM UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 $\,$ 1, 2019.
