- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, except under certain circumstances, a person from disclosing certain information obtained or generated in the course of exercising the 5 Commissioner of Financial Regulation's authority to investigate certain licensed 6 persons; expanding the definition of "licensed persons" to include certain registered 7 8 persons and licensed or registered credit reporting agencies and credit services 9 businesses authorizing the denial of certain records of an investigation; and generally relating to the disclosure of information obtained or generated in the 10 course of exercising the Commissioner of Financial Regulation's authority to 11 examine or investigate licensed persons records of an investigation by the 12 Commissioner of Financial Regulation. 13
