ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2021, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY PAINT OR COATING REMOVAL PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS N-METHYLPYRROLIDONE (NMP) OR METHYLENE CHLORIDE, ALSO KNOWN AS DICHLOROMETHANE (DCM). (B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION
