## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Health – Sale or Distribution of Trichloroethylene – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, on or after a certain date, a person from selling or  
4 distributing in commerce an aerosol degreaser or a spot cleaner for dry cleaning that  
5 contains trichloroethylene; establishing a certain penalty for a certain violation; and  
6 generally relating to a prohibition on the sale or distribution of products containing  
7 trichloroethylene.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Health – General**

16 **24–308.**

17 **(A) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2021, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR**  
18 **DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY COMMERCIAL OR CONSUMER AEROSOL DEGREASER**  
19 **OR A SPOT CLEANER FOR DRY CLEANING THAT CONTAINS TRICHLOROETHYLENE**  
20 **(TCE).**

21 **(B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION**  
22 **ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**  
23 **MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000**
