5	(a) An application for a permit shall be made under oath.
6 7	(b) (1) Subject to subsections (c) and (d) of this section, the Secretary may charge a nonrefundable fee payable when an application is filed for a permit.
8	(2) The fee may not exceed:
9	(i) \$75 for an initial application;
10	(ii) \$50 for a renewal or subsequent application; and
11	(iii) \$10 for a duplicate or modified permit.
12 13	(3) The fees under this subsection are in addition to the fees authorized under \S 5–305 of this subtitle.
14 15	(c) The Secretary may reduce the fee under subsection (b) of this section accordingly for a permit that is granted for one day only and at one place only.
16	(d) The Secretary may not charge a fee under subsection (b) of this section to:
17 18	(1) a State, county, or municipal public safety employee who is required to carry, wear, or transport a handgun as a condition of governmental employment; or
