1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Retirement and Pension System - Designated Beneficiary Change - Rescission

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain retirees of the State Retirement and Pension 5 System to rescind a request to change a designated beneficiary by sending certain 6 notice to the State Retirement Agency before a certain allowance payment normally 7 becomes due; allowing a retiree who rescinds a certain change of designated 8 beneficiary in a timely manner to receive the allowance payable prior to the change 9 of designated beneficiary, without a certain retroactive adjustment; making 10 conforming changes; and generally relating to designation of a beneficiary with the 11 State Retirement and Pension System.
