A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore County Public Schools – Capital Project Scoring System

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Board of Education, on or before a 4 certain date, to develop and implement a scoring system for evaluating certain $\mathbf{5}$ projects; requiring the scoring system to prioritize certain projects; requiring the 6 board, on or before certain dates, to apply the scoring system to projects for certain 7 public school facilities, publish the project scores on the Baltimore County Public 8 School System's website, and report the project scores to certain members of the 9 General Assembly; requiring the board, on or before certain dates, to use a certain scoring system to update certain project evaluations and publish and report certain 10 11 scores; defining certain terms; and generally relating to public school facilities in 12Baltimore County.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Education
- 21 **4–135.**

22 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 23 INDICATED.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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1 (2) "BOARD" MEANS THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF 2 EDUCATION.

3 (3) "PROJECT" MEANS THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION,
4 RECONSTRUCTION, EQUIPPING, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OR RENOVATION OF ANY
5 PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY.

6 (4) "PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY" MEANS A BUILDING, A PARKING 7 FACILITY, AN ATHLETIC FACILITY, A TESTING FACILITY, OR ANY OTHER FACILITY IN 8 BALTIMORE COUNTY, NOW EXISTING OR HEREAFTER ACQUIRED OR CONSTRUCTED, 9 THAT IS USED BY THE BOARD IN RELATION TO THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS IN THE 10 BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

11 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2020, THE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP 12 AND IMPLEMENT A SCORING SYSTEM FOR EVALUATING PROJECTS THAT SERVE THE 13 LONG-RANGE PLANS OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

14(2)THE SCORING SYSTEM SHALL PRIORITIZE SCHOOL BUILDINGS15THAT:

16 (I) ARE MORE THAN 50 YEARS OLD; AND

17(II)HAVE NOT BEEN IMPROVED BY A MAJOR RENOVATION IN18THE PAST 15 YEARS.

19 (C) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2022, THE BOARD SHALL:

20 (1) APPLY THE SCORING SYSTEM DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION 21 (B) OF THIS SECTION TO PROJECTS FOR 75% OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES 22 THAT ARE:

23(I)OPERATED BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL24SYSTEM; AND

25 (II) UTILIZED BY STUDENTS;

26 (2) PUBLISH THE PROJECT SCORES ON THE BALTIMORE COUNTY 27 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM'S WEBSITE; AND

28 (3) REPORT THE PROJECT SCORES TO THE MEMBERS OF THE 29 BALTIMORE COUNTY DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE 30 WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

31 (D) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2023, THE BOARD SHALL:

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(1) APPLY THE SCORING SYSTEM DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION
 (B) OF THIS SECTION TO PROJECTS FOR THE REMAINING 25% OF PUBLIC SCHOOL
 FACILITIES DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION;

- 4 (2) PUBLISH THE PROJECT SCORES ON THE BALTIMORE COUNTY 5 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM'S WEBSITE; AND
- 6 (3) REPORT THE PROJECT SCORES TO THE MEMBERS OF THE 7 BALTIMORE COUNTY DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE 8 WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 9 (E) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2025, AND EVERY 2 YEARS THEREAFTER, 10 THE BOARD SHALL:
- (1) UPDATE THE EVALUATION OF PROJECTS FOR EACH PUBLIC
 SCHOOL FACILITY USING THE SCORING SYSTEM DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION
 (B) OF THIS SECTION;
- 14 (2) PUBLISH THE UPDATED PROJECT SCORES ON THE BALTIMORE 15 COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM'S WEBSITE; AND
- 16 (3) REPORT THE UPDATED PROJECT SCORES TO THE MEMBERS OF 17 THE BALTIMORE COUNTY DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN 18 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 20 1, 2019.
