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1 (B) THE EXEMPTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT 2 APPLY TO THE CLEANING OF A COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL BUILDING OR THE 3 PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE BUILDING THAT IS USED FOR A PURPOSE THAT 4 REQUIRES THE COLLECTION OF THE SALES AND USE TAX UNDER THIS TITLE.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 6 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 7 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to 8 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 9 enacted.
