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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County – Commissioners – Residency Requirements**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each County Commissioner of Somerset County to reside in  
4 a certain commissioners' district for a certain amount of time before election as a  
5 Commissioner and during the term of office as Commissioner; prohibiting a  
6 Commissioner from continuing to serve during the current term of office if the  
7 Commissioner does not maintain a certain residency under certain circumstances;  
8 authorizing an incumbent Commissioner who no longer resides in a certain district  
9 due to a change in the district's boundaries to continue as a Commissioner for the  
10 remainder of the term of office; and generally relating to residency requirements for  
11 the County Commissioners of Somerset County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 20 – Somerset County**

1 (a) There are 5 County Commissioners for Somerset County, who hold office for 4  
2 years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

3 (B) (1) A COMMISSIONER ELECTED FROM A COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICT  
4 DESCRIBED IN § 2-102 OF THIS SUBTITLE MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THAT DISTRICT  
5 DURING:

6 (I) THE 6 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE FILING  
7 DEADLINE FOR THE ELECTION OF THE COMMISSIONER; AND

8 (II) THE FULL TERM OF OFFICE AS A COMMISSIONER.

9 (2) A COMMISSIONER FROM A COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICT WHO DOES  
10 NOT MAINTAIN RESIDENCY IN THAT DISTRICT MAY NOT CONTINUE AS A COUNTY  
11 COMMISSIONER AND THE OFFICE SHALL BE DEEMED VACANT.

12 (3) IF THE BOUNDARY OF A COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICT IS CHANGED,  
13 THE TERM OF AN INCUMBENT COMMISSIONER WHO NO LONGER RESIDES IN THAT  
14 DISTRICT BECAUSE OF THE CHANGE IS NOT AFFECTED DURING THAT TERM.

15 [(b)] (C) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each  
16 Commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$8,500.

17 (2) The President of the County Commissioners shall receive an annual  
18 salary of \$9,500.

19 [(c)] (D) Each Commissioner may receive reimbursement of no more than \$3,000  
20 a year for expenses incurred for any official duties. The County Commissioner shall submit  
21 a reimbursement voucher, signed by 3 of the 5 Commissioners.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 October 1, 2019.
