BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 5-413.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 5-413.1.
