## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sunday Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Baltimore County the holder of a manufacturer’s license  
4 or a wholesaler’s license to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a holder of a retail  
5 alcoholic beverages license on Sunday; authorizing holders of certain classes of retail  
6 alcoholic beverages licenses to sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday during the same  
7 hours as on the other days of the week; making certain conforming changes; and  
8 generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday in Baltimore County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 A holder of a manufacturer's license may sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a  
5 holder of a retail license from 6 a.m. to midnight on [every day except] **MONDAY THROUGH**  
6 **Sunday**.

7 13-502.

8 Except as provided in § 13-503 of this subtitle, a holder of a wholesaler's license may  
9 sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a holder of a retail license from 6 a.m. to midnight on  
10 [every day except] **MONDAY THROUGH Sunday**.

11 13-2003.

12 (a) [(1)] A holder of a Class A beer and wine license may sell beer and wine on  
13 Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to midnight.

14 [(2)] From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., the license holder may sell beer and wine on the  
15 Sunday immediately before:

16 (i) Christmas Day;

17 (ii) New Year's Day;

18 (iii) Rosh Hashanah; and

19 (iv) Yom Kippur.

20 (3) The license holder may sell beer and wine on the two Sundays  
21 immediately before Passover if:

22 (i) the license holder does not sell beer and wine on the two  
23 Saturdays immediately before Passover;

24 (ii) the sales are conducted on those Sundays from 6 a.m. to  
25 midnight; and

26 (iii) the sales are limited to beer and wine that are "kosher for  
27 Passover".]

28 (b) (1) A holder of a Class B beer and wine license may sell beer and wine on

1 [each day of the week] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following  
2 day.

3 (2) The license holder may sell beer and wine at a bar or counter on  
4 Sunday.

5 (3) [From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., the] **A** holder of a Class B on-sale and off-sale  
6 beer and wine license may sell beer and wine for off-premises consumption [on the Sunday  
7 immediately before:

8 (i) Christmas Day;

9 (ii) New Year's Day;

10 (iii) Rosh Hashanah; and

11 (iv) Yom Kippur] **ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M.**  
12 **TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

13 (c) (1) A holder of a Class C beer and wine license may sell beer and wine on  
14 [each day of the week] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following  
15 day.

16 (2) The license holder may sell beer and wine at a bar or counter on  
17 Sunday.

18 (d) (1) A holder of a Class D beer and wine license may sell beer and wine on  
19 Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

20 (2) [From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., a] **A** holder of a Class D on-sale and off-sale  
21 beer and wine license may sell beer and wine for off-premises consumption on [the Sunday  
22 immediately before:

23 (i) Christmas Day;

24 (ii) New Year's Day;

25 (iii) Rosh Hashanah; and

26 (iv) Yom Kippur] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2**  
27 **A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

28 13-2004.

29 (a) [(1)] A holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
30 and liquor on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to midnight.

1                    [(2) From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor  
2 on the Sunday immediately before:

- 3                    (i) Christmas Day;
- 4                    (ii) New Year's Day;
- 5                    (iii) Rosh Hashanah; and
- 6                    (iv) Yom Kippur.

7                    (3) A license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor on the two Sundays  
8 immediately before Passover if:

- 9                    (i) the license holder does not sell beer, wine, and liquor on the two  
10 Saturdays immediately before Passover;
- 11                    (ii) the off-premises sales are conducted on those Sundays from 6  
12 a.m. to midnight; and
- 13                    (iii) the sales are limited to beer, wine, and liquor that are "kosher  
14 for Passover".]

15                    (b) (1) A holder of a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
16 and liquor Monday through Sunday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

17                    (2) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on  
18 Sunday.

19                    (3) [From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., the] **A** holder of a Class B **ON-SALE AND**  
20 **OFF-SALE** beer, wine, and liquor [(on- and off-sale)] license may sell beer, wine, and liquor  
21 for off-premises consumption on [the Sunday immediately before:

- 22                    (i) Christmas Day;
- 23                    (ii) New Year's Day;
- 24                    (iii) Rosh Hashanah; and
- 25                    (iv) Yom Kippur] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2**  
26 **A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

27                    (c) (1) A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
28 and liquor on [each day of the week] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY** from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m.  
29 the following day.

1                   (2)     The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on  
2 Sunday.

3           (d)     (1)     A holder of a Class D beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
4 and liquor on Monday through Sunday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

5                   (2)     [From 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., a] A holder of a Class D on-sale and off-sale  
6 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor for off-premises consumption  
7 on [the Sunday immediately before:

8                           (i)     Christmas Day;

9                           (ii)    New Year's Day;

10                          (iii)   Rosh Hashanah; and

11                          (iv)    Yom Kippur] **MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2**  
12 **A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

13           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
14 1, 2019.
