- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 (2) "Alcoholic beverage" means a spirituous, vinous, malt, or fermented 19 liquor, liquid, or compound that contains at least 0.5% alcohol by volume and is fit for 20 beverage purposes.

- 21 (3) (i) "Passenger area" means an area that:
- 1. Is designed to seat the driver and any passenger of a motor
 vehicle while the motor vehicle is in operation; or

2.Is readily accessible to the driver or a passenger of a motor 1 $\mathbf{2}$ vehicle while in their seating positions. "Passenger area" does not include: 3 (ii) 1. A locked glove compartment; 4 2. The trunk of a motor vehicle; or $\mathbf{5}$ 6 3. If a motor vehicle is not equipped with a trunk, the area 7 behind the rearmost upright seat or an area that is not normally occupied by the driver or 8 a passenger of the motor vehicle. 9 This section applies to a motor vehicle that is driven, stopped, standing, or (b) 10 otherwise located on a highway. 11 (c) A driver of a motor vehicle may not consume an alcoholic beverage in a 12passenger area of a motor vehicle on a highway. A DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE MAY NOT SMOKE OR OTHERWISE 13**(D)** 14CONSUME MARIJUANA IN A PASSENGER AREA OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ON A HIGHWAY. 15**(E)** AN OCCUPANT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE MAY NOT SMOKE MARIJUANA IN A 16PASSENGER AREA OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ON A HIGHWAY. 17[(d)] **(F)** Notwithstanding § 6-320, § 6-321, or § 6-322 of the Alcoholic 18Beverages Article, or any other provision of law, the prohibition contained in this section applies throughout the State. 19 20SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21October 1, 2019.
