## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Cosmetologists – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Cosmetologists in accordance with the  
4 provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a  
5 certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory  
6 authority of the Board; requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes  
7 and regulations that relate to the Board be performed on or before a certain date;  
8 and generally relating to the State Board of Cosmetologists.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program  
3 Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and  
4 be of no effect after July 1, [2021] **2024**.

5 **Article – State Government**

6 8-403.

7 (a) On or before December 15 of the evaluation year specified, the Department  
8 shall:

9 (1) conduct a preliminary evaluation of each governmental activity or unit  
10 to be evaluated under this section; and

11 (2) prepare a report on each preliminary evaluation conducted.

12 (b) Each of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and  
13 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units are subject to preliminary  
14 evaluation in the evaluation year specified:

15 (13) Cosmetologists, State Board of (§ 5-201 of the Business Occupations  
16 and Professions Article: [2018] **2021**);

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 2019.
