- 16 (a) An employer may not discharge a covered employee from employment [solely]
- 17 because the covered employee files a claim for compensation under this title.
- 18 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction
- 19 is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.
