A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Unemployment Insurance – Exemption From Covered Employment – Bulk**
3 **Vending Item Assembly**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that work performed by individuals engaged in the light
5 assembly of bulk vending items for bulk vending machines is not covered
6 employment under the unemployment insurance law under certain circumstances;
7 and generally relating to exemptions from covered employment under the
8 unemployment insurance law.

9 BY adding to

10 Article – Labor and Employment

11 Section 8–206(j)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Labor and Employment**

17 8–206.

18 **(J) WORK PERFORMED BY AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN THE LIGHT**
19 **ASSEMBLY OF BULK VENDING ITEMS FOR BULK VENDING MACHINES IS NOT**
20 **COVERED EMPLOYMENT IF THE SECRETARY IS SATISFIED THAT:**

21 **(1) THE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMS THE WORK IN THE INDIVIDUAL’S**
22 **HOME;**

23 **(2) THE WORK IS PERFORMED ACCORDING TO SPECIFICATIONS**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 FURNISHED BY THE PERSON FOR WHOM THE SERVICES ARE PERFORMED;

2 (3) THE WORK IS PERFORMED ON BULK VENDING ITEMS FURNISHED
3 BY THE PERSON FOR WHOM THE SERVICES ARE PERFORMED;

4 (4) THE BULK VENDING ITEMS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE PERSON
5 FOR WHOM THE SERVICES ARE PERFORMED OR THAT PERSON'S DESIGNEE; AND

6 (5) THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES LESS THAN \$750 PER QUARTER FOR
7 THE LIGHT ASSEMBLING OF BULK VENDING ITEMS.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2019.
