A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland Department of Health – Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Services – Needs Assessment Study

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to conduct a certain 5 study to determine the existing capacity and estimated unmet needs for mental 6 health and substance use disorder services by region of the State; requiring that the 7 review of mental health services include certain services; requiring that the study 8 include a review of certain issues related to certain services; authorizing the 9 Department to contract with an entity to conduct the study; requiring the Governor 10 to include a certain appropriation in the State budget in a certain fiscal year for the 11 study; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to the Governor and the 12 General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to a study of 13 mental health and substance use disorder services by the Maryland Department of 14 Health.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That:

- (a) The Maryland Department of Health shall conduct a comprehensive statewide study to determine the existing capacity and estimated unmet needs for mental health and substance use disorder services by region of the State.
- 20 (b) The review of mental health services under this section shall include services 21 for developmental disabilities and behavioral disabilities.
- 22 (c) The study shall include a review of the following issues related to mental 23 health and substance use disorder services for adults and adolescents:
 - (1) the average daily capacity of:
