- 18 OPERATOR OF A STORAGE WAREHOUSE SHALL:
- 19 (1) OBTAIN AND STORE NALOXONE AND THE NECESSARY
- 20 PARAPHERNALIA FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF NALOXONE ON THE PREMISES; AND
- 21 (2) MAKE NALOXONE AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS TO ADMINISTER TO
- 22 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OR IN GOOD FAITH IS BELIEVED TO BE EXPERIENCING AN
