- FOR the purpose of requiring the Spending Affordability Committee, on or before a certain
 date, to study certain information and make certain recommendations to the
 Governor and the General Assembly; providing for the termination of this Act; and
 generally relating to a study by the Spending Affordability Committee.
- 7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,8 That:
- 9 (a) The Spending Affordability Committee shall:
- 10 (1) study the impact of a recession on the utilization of social safety net 11 programs; and
- 12 (2) make recommendations regarding:
- (i) establishing subaccounts in the State Reserve Fund to be used
 during a recession to avoid a reduction in social safety net programs;
- (ii) requiring the Governor to appropriate funds to the subaccountsduring times of economic expansion; and
- 17 (iii) determining when it is appropriate to access funds in the 18 subaccounts.
- (b) On or before December 31, 2019, the Spending Affordability Committee shall
 report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246
 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
