## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Mobile Carrying Device – Definition**

3 FOR the purpose of defining “mobile carrying device” for purposes of the Maryland Vehicle  
4 Law; altering a certain definition to specify that a mobile carrying device is not a  
5 vehicle for purposes of the Maryland Vehicle Law; and generally relating to mobile  
6 carrying devices.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Transportation**

20 **11–133.1.**

21 **“MOBILE CARRYING DEVICE” MEANS AN ELECTRICALLY POWERED DEVICE**  
22 **THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH TECHNOLOGY TO TRANSPORT PERSONAL PROPERTY WITH**  
23 **THE ACTIVE MONITORING OF THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY AND THAT:**

1                   **(1) IS DESIGNED TO REMAIN WITHIN 25 FEET OF THE OWNER OF THE**  
2 **PROPERTY;**

3                   **(2) IS OPERATED ON A SIDEWALK, A CROSSWALK, OR ANY OTHER**  
4 **PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY;**

5                   **(3) WEIGHS LESS THAN 90 POUNDS, EXCLUDING CARGO; AND**

6                   **(4) HAS A MAXIMUM SPEED CAPABILITY NOT EXCEEDING 12.5 MILES**  
7 **PER HOUR.**

9           (a)   (1)   “Vehicle” means, except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, any  
10 device in, on, or by which any individual or property is or might be transported or towed on  
11 a highway.

12                   (2)   “Vehicle” includes a low speed vehicle and an off–highway recreational  
13 vehicle.

14           (b)   “Vehicle” does not include [an]:

15                   **(1) AN electric personal assistive mobility device as defined in §**  
16 **21–101(j) of this article; OR**

17                   **(2) A MOBILE CARRYING DEVICE, AS DEFINED IN § 11–133.1 OF THIS**  
18 **SUBTITLE.**

19           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 2019.
