3	FOR the purpose of requiring certain health care facilities to screen for hypertension each
4	patient receiving health care services from the health care facility; requiring that the
5	screening consist of at least one certain screening test; requiring a health care
6	provider who obtains a certain result on a certain screening to provide a certain
7	referral for treatment and services; defining a certain term; and generally relating
8	to blood pressure screening.

15	WHEREAS, The goal of this Act is to reduce the number of individuals untreated
16	high blood pressure that leads to strokes and other cardiovascular diseases and deaths; and
17	WHEREAS, African Americans have the highest percentage of high blood pressure
18	that results in stroke or other cardiovascular diseases and deaths, as well as damage to the
19	kidneys, which result in being placed on dialysis; now, therefore,
20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "HEALTH CARE FACILITY" MEANS:
4	(1) A HOSPITAL, AS DEFINED IN § 19–301 OF THIS TITLE;

7 8	(3) A FREESTANDING AMBULATORY CARE FACILITY, AS DEFINED IN 19–3B–01 OF THIS TITLE; OR
9 10	(4) A FACILITY OFFERING PRIMARY OR SPECIALTY HEALTH CARI SERVICES.
11 12 13	(B) (1) EACH HEALTH CARE FACILITY SHALL SCREEN FOR HYPERTENSION EACH PATIENT RECEIVING HEALTH CARE SERVICES FROM THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY.
14 15 16	(2) THE SCREENING REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SCREENING TESTS:
17	(I) OFFICE BLOOD PRESSURE MEASUREMENT;
18	(II) AMBULATORY BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORING;
19	(III) HOME BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORING; OR
20 21	(IV) ANY OTHER BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENING TEST APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY.
22 23 24	(C) A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WHO OBTAINS A RESULT FROM A SCREENING FOR HYPERTENSION CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE A REFERRAL FOR TREATMENT

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.

AND SUPPORT SERVICES IF RESULTS INDICATE ELEVATED BLOOD PRESSURE.
