# 10(C)TO ENSURE THAT ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS DO NOT SUBSIDIZE THE COST11OF BROADBAND SERVICES, AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE SHALL ALLOCATE12PROPERLY ALL COSTS INCURRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(12) OF THIS SECTION13BETWEEN ELECTRICITY-RELATED SERVICES AND BROADBAND SERVICES.
