## Health Care Facilities - Change in Bed Capacity - Certificate of Need Exemption

FOR the purpose of exempting an increase or decrease in bed capacity from the certificate 4  $\mathbf{5}$ of need requirement if the increase or decrease will occur in an certain intermediate 6 care facility, or a certain general hospice program, or a certain hospital with acute 7 psychiatric beds under certain circumstances and certain written notice is filed with the Maryland Health Care Commission at least a certain number of days before 8 9 increasing or decreasing bed capacity; requiring the Commission to review a certain 10 chapter of the State Health Plan and, under certain circumstances, report to certain 11 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; making a technical change; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to 12 13certificates of need for a change in bed capacity.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (h) (1) A certificate of need is required before the bed capacity of a health care
3 facility is changed.
4 (2) This subsection does not apply to any increase or decrease in bed

5 capacity if:

- 6 (i) For a health care facility that is not a hospital, during a 2-year 7 period the increase or decrease would not exceed the lesser of 10 percent of the total bed 8 capacity or 10 beds;
- 9 (ii) 1. The increase or decrease would change the bed capacity 10 for an existing medical service; and

11 2. A. The change would not increase total bed capacity;

12 B. The change is maintained for at least a 1–year period; and

C. At least 45 days prior to the change, the hospital provides written notice to the Commission describing the change and providing an updated inventory of the hospital's licensed bed complement;

- 16 (iii) 1. At least 45 days before increasing or decreasing bed 17 capacity, written notice of intent to change bed capacity is filed with the Commission;
- 18 2. The Commission in its sole discretion finds that the19 proposed change:
- 20 A. Is pursuant to the consolidation or merger of two or more 21 health care facilities, or conversion of a health care facility or part of a facility to a 22 nonhealth-related use;
- B. Is not inconsistent with the State health plan or the institution-specific plan developed by the Commission;
