- FOR the purpose of authorizing an institution of higher education, under certain circumstances, to notify the parent or legal guardian of a student who is addicted to drugs, at risk of a drug overdose, or at risk of death from drug use; providing for the immunity of an institution of higher education from civil liability in a tort claim under State law for making a certain disclosure; and generally relating to

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education

- 18 (A) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY NOTIFY THE PARENT OR
- 19 LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT WHO IS ADDICTED TO DRUGS, AT RISK OF A DRUG
- 20 OVERDOSE, OR AT RISK OF DEATH FROM DRUG USE IF:
- 21 (1) THE INFORMATION THAT WILL BE USED TO NOTIFY THE PARENT
- 22 OR LEGAL GUARDIAN IS CONFIDENTIAL UNDER A PRIVACY LAW OR POLICY AND MAY
- 23 BE DISCLOSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN EXCEPTION IN THE LAW OR POLICY,

- 6 (2) THE STUDENT PROVIDES WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FOR THE 7 INSTITUTION TO NOTIFY THE STUDENT'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN; OR
- 8 (3) THE DISCLOSURE DOES NOT CONTAIN INFORMATION THAT IS 9 SUBJECT TO ANY PRIVACY LAW OR POLICY.
- 10 (B) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL
 11 LIABILITY IN A TORT CLAIM UNDER STATE LAW FOR DISCLOSING INFORMATION IN
