2 Higher Education – Policy on Student Concerns About Athletic Programs and Activities

FOR the purpose of requiring each institution of higher education to develop and adopt a 4 certain policy that meets certain requirements on or before a certain date; 5 6 authorizing an institution of higher education to make changes to the policy under 7 certain circumstances; requiring each institution of higher education to post the 8 policy and any changes to the policy on the institution's website; requiring each 9 institution of higher education to ensure that each student who participates in the 10 institution's athletic programs or activities has a copy of the policy and any changes 11 to the policy; requiring each institution of higher education to submit to the 12 Maryland Higher Education Commission and certain committees of the General 13 Assembly the policy and any changes to the policy by a certain date; requiring each institution of higher education to submit to the Commission on or before a certain 14 15 date each year the number of students who shared concerns under the policy; 16 requiring the Commission to report a summary of certain submissions to certain 17 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; providing 18 for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a policy on student concerns 19 about athletic programs and activities.
