13 14 15	WHEREAS, It is necessary to take steps to ensure the continued viability of dairy farming and to assure consumers of an adequate, local supply of pure and wholesome milk; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, The dairy industry is an essential agricultural activity and dairy farms, and associated suppliers, marketers, and processors, and retailers, are an integral component of the region's economy; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has not provided consistent guidance to the State Department of Agriculture, dairy farms, associated suppliers, marketers, processors, retailers, and consumers on the application of the established standard of identity of milk as defined in 21 C.F.R. § 131.110; and

The Maryland Department of Health shall notify the Department of Legislative Services within 10 days after 11 of these 14 states have enacted an act that is similar to this Act. If notice of enactment is not received by the Department of Legislative Services on or before October 1, 2029, this Act with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be null and void.
