A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Labor and Employment – Grant Program for Workforce Skills Assessment**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Grant Program for Workforce Skills Assessment in the
4 Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; providing for the purpose of the
5 Program; authorizing the Governor to include an annual appropriation to the
6 Program in the State budget; requiring the Department to implement and
7 administer the Program; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations;
8 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Grant Program for Workforce
9 Skills Assessment.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Labor and Employment**

18 **11–603.**

19 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “PROGRAM” MEANS THE GRANT PROGRAM FOR**
20 **WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT.**

21 **(B) THERE IS A GRANT PROGRAM FOR WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT**
22 **IN THE DEPARTMENT.**

23 **(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 ASSISTANCE TO AN EMPLOYER FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ASSESSMENTS THAT
2 MEASURE WORKPLACE OR JOB-RELATED SKILLS OF EMPLOYEES WHO ARE STATE
3 RESIDENTS.

4 (D) THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET AN ANNUAL
5 APPROPRIATION TO THE PROGRAM.

6 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE
7 PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

8 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS
9 SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS TO:

10 (1) DEVELOP REQUIREMENTS FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS;

11 (2) DEVELOP A PROCESS FOR REVIEWING GRANT APPLICATIONS AND
12 AWARDED GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYERS; AND

13 (3) DETERMINE A CAP FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A GRANT THAT
14 AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYER MAY RECEIVE EACH YEAR.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2019.
