- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain sheriff to appoint certain correctional deputies; 4 providing that certain correctional deputies serve under a certain sheriff; requiring $\mathbf{5}$ certain correctional officers to complete certain training provided by a certain 6 commission; providing that certain correctional deputies may become merit system 7 employees under certain circumstances; providing that certain correctional deputies 8 may be dismissed without cause under certain circumstances; making stylistic 9 changes; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of this Act; providing 10for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to 11 correctional deputies in Calvert County.

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take 4 effect on the taking effect of Chapter _____ (S.B. 206) of the Acts of the General Assembly 5 of 2019. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of 6 no further force and effect.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of
Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
