## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Seasonal Closing**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of months that the Board of License  
4 Commissioners for Harford County may authorize for a seasonally operated licensed  
5 premises to be closed under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic  
6 beverages in Harford County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 22–102.

21 This title applies only in Harford County.

1           The Board may authorize the closing of a licensed premises for not more than ~~[6]~~ **9**  
2 months if:

3                   (1)    the Board determines that the licensed premises is seasonally operated;  
4 and

5                   (2)    the license holder submits a written request to the Board at least 30  
6 days before:

7                           (i)    the anticipated date of closing; and

8                           (ii)   the anticipated date of reopening.

9           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
10 1, 2019.
