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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Congressional Districting Plan – Sixth and Eighth Congressional Districts**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the composition of the sixth and eighth districts in the  
4 State of Maryland for the election of members to the United States House of  
5 Representatives; specifying certain election district and precinct boundaries; making  
6 this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the reconfiguration of  
7 congressional districts in the State.

18 Preamble

19 WHEREAS, The census mandated under Article I, § 2 of the U.S. Constitution  
20 informs the decennial reapportionment and redistricting process, with the last census  
21 having occurred in 2010; and

22 WHEREAS, The General Assembly of Maryland entered into a Special Session in  
23 2011 for the purpose of adopting Maryland’s congressional districts for the following 10  
24 years; and

1 WHEREAS, The U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland, sitting as a  
2 three-judge panel which included a judge from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth  
3 Circuit, ruled in November 2018 that Maryland's Sixth Congressional District violates the  
4 First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution, and in its judgment issued on November 7, 2018,  
5 stated, "...the State might be well advised to establish a neutral commission to develop a  
6 conforming plan", and entered an order (1) permanently enjoining the State "from  
7 conducting any further elections for members of the U.S. House of Representatives from  
8 Maryland under the 2011 congressional redistricting plan" and (2) directing the State to  
9 adopt promptly a new congressional redistricting plan that addresses "the constitutional  
10 violations found here with respect to [the Sixth] District" for use in the 2020 election; and

11 WHEREAS, On November 26, 2018, the Governor of Maryland issued Executive  
12 Order 01.01.2018.29, which established an Emergency Commission on Sixth Congressional  
13 District Gerrymandering (the "Commission") for the purpose of redrawing the Sixth  
14 District and any other districts necessary to conform the Sixth District to requirements of  
15 the First Amendment; and

16 WHEREAS, The Commission held public meetings and work sessions to consider  
17 how best to redraw the Sixth District; and

18 WHEREAS, On March 1, 2019, the Commission made recommendations to redraw  
19 the Sixth and Eighth districts on the basis of compactness and geographic contiguity and  
20 without regard to any partisan considerations and held two public hearings in the two  
21 newly proposed districts to obtain input from citizens on the proposed new districts; and

22 WHEREAS, This Act implements the recommendations of the Commission on  
23 redrawing the Sixth and Eighth Congressional districts; and

24 WHEREAS, Failure to adopt a new plan for the Sixth Congressional District could  
25 result in the U.S. District Court adopting its own plan with little or no input from State  
26 policy makers; and

27 WHEREAS, The integrity of the redistricting process is essential to the success of  
28 democracy; and

29 WHEREAS, The process of redistricting should be fully transparent and subject to  
30 public input and scrutiny; and

31 WHEREAS, Free and fair elections are the right of every citizen in the United States,  
32 and the map proposed by the Commission will enable a large number of Maryland voters  
33 to participate more fully in congressional elections; now, therefore,

34 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
35 That Section(s) 8-707 and 8-709 of Article – Election Law of the Annotated Code of  
36 Maryland be repealed.

37 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read

21           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency  
22 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has  
23 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to  
24 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is  
25 enacted.
