The Boys & Girls Club of Westminster, a 501 3 non-profit, serves over 350 members ages 6 -18 with after school and summer camp programs. Our mission is to enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens. Our vision is to provide a world-class Club Experience that assures success is within reach of every young person who comes through our doors, with all members on track to graduate from high school with a plan for the future, demonstrating good character and citizenship, and living a healthy lifestyle.
