10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Town of Laytonsville is 126 years old with a population of 500 residents. The Town provides local government to its citizens and works to preserve a small town identity. The Town goals are to increase the sense of community and improve the connectivity of the various sections of the Town through paths, walkways and trails. This infrastructure will form the basis of the Town's concept for a walkable community. The Town Mayor and Council members are committed to maintaining and enhancing community activities. Annual events such as a parade through the Town, a community-wide picnic with attendance of 300 people, a community tree lighting event where children from the Laytonsville Elementary School participate, and other activities with Boy and Girl Scouts and the Laytonsville Lions Club.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Miller Park is located at 21633 Second Street in Laytonsville. This one-acre park supports the Town vision by preserving open space and providing a community friendly area. Our neighborhoods need community areas where families can meet to socialize and play. The Town Council expects its residents and members of the greater Laytonsville community will have access and use of the park. The Dolores R. Miller Park has been in the planning stage for 10 years. Currently the park includes one acre of grass and a small number of trees. When completed, this will be a passive park with limited facilities such as benches, a bike rack and a water fountain. An asphalt trail will circle through the park and connect with other trails in Town. Several areas will be transformed into flower gardens and a copper beach tree will be planted in the center of the park. The Town also anticipates this park will be used for community gatherings.
