10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>The Greenway Avenue Stadium Capital Improvement Fund was formed in October 2017. It is comprised of twelve community individuals. Its sole purpose is to raise funds for the community venue known as Greenway Avenue Stadium. The stadium is used by two public high schools, Fort Hill and Allegany, for football, boys and girls soccer, boys and girls track, band performances, and cheerleading. It is also used by local youth football and soccer leagues, and by older citizens who walk the track for exercise.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The bond initiative is to secure funding for the upgrade and improvement of the stadium lighting on the visitors side. The home side lighting was upgraded when the home side was newly constructed several years ago. By comparison the visitor side lighting is inadequate and creates shadows on the field.
