10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

"GNFA" (Guru Nanak Foundation of America) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that has been operating a Sikh gurdwara (house of worship) in Silver Spring, MD since 1970. In addition to the Sikh community, GNFA has been serving the larger community with its open and free meals (langar), and educational, social, cultural and health programs. It has a robust weekly seniors program, offering health seminars, yoga, dance and healthy-cooking classes. Since 2014, GNFA has been organizing an annual free health fair with free lab tests, educational sessions, blood donation drive, consultation with physicians and resources for the underserved and uninsured. GNFA is now starting a clinic (The GNFA Health Clinic) that plans to operate on weekends to serve the uninsured and underinsured.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

GNFA has organized Annual Health Fairs since 2014. Every year around 500 attendees with restricted access due to barriers of language, transportation, and lack of insurance and health literacy, have been served. They include Vietnamese, Chinese, Latino, African-Americans, and several Indian communities. The most common feedback received on exit surveys has been to run a clinic at our site so there is follow-up and continuity of care. Though we have a large pool of committed medical volunteers to operate a well-run clinic, we have only two small rooms available. We need funds to provide a state-of-the art facility for the greater good of the community. The GNFA Health Clinic hopes to have a building with exam rooms, office, waiting area, lab room, restrooms, as well as a site to store medications, records, and health-related equipment, thereby serving a larger population more effectively.
