All programs provide scholarships, free tickets, or are free or low-cost admission. Our programs are designed to strengthen the broad community and State and connect people to each other through the arts, conversation, group experiences, and dialogue. The 1932 historic building is in the midst of a \$23 million improvement program that is updating, renovating, and refurbishing the facilities and constructing new ones to increase public access to and enjoyment of the arts.
