10. Description and Purpose of Organiz					

Since its founding in 1977, NCIA, a 501(c)(3) corporation, has been working on behalf of intellectually disabled adults, youth and other disadvantaged populations in Maryland. NCIA has over 600 employees and its headquarters has been in the Woodlawn area of Baltimore County since the late 1980s. One of our major programs is our Youth In Transition (YIT) School. For over 20 years, NCIA's YIT School has served the educational needs of children unable to participate in traditional school programs. We are licensed by the Maryland Department of Education. NCIA's adult program provides residential and vocational services to over 350 individuals with intellectual disabilities.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The NCIA facilities located at 7130 Rutherford Road requires an immediate replacement of its heating and air conditioning equipment due to the age (40-years-old) and the inability to keep it operating. NCIA will continue to acquire properties that are accessible to support individuals aging in place as well as accommodating individuals with physical disabilities.
