- (a) There are two classes of State militia:
 - (1) the organized militia; and
 - (2) the unorganized militia.
- (b) The organized militia of the State consists of:
 - (1) the National Guard;
 - (2) the Inactive National Guard; and
 - (3) the Maryland Defense Force.
- (c) The unorganized militia consists of those individuals described under § 13-202 of this subtitle but who are not regularly enlisted or commissioned in the organized militia.
