AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1300
(First Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 3, in line 42, after “Maryland;” insert “requiring a public school student in elementary school to be provided a certain minimum level of a program of physical activity each week; requiring that the program of physical activity for a certain category of student be consistent with a certain program for the student; requiring public elementary schools to designate a certain group to plan and coordinate certain activities;”.

On page 5, in line 29, after “7-202.1;” insert “7-409.1 and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 162, after line 2, insert:

“7-409.1.

(A) (1) A STUDENT IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SHALL BE PROVIDED A DAILY PROGRAM OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY TOTALING 150 MINUTES EACH WEEK, INCLUDING A MINIMUM OF 90 MINUTES EACH WEEK OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

(2) ANY MINUTES NOT CONSISTING OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION SHALL CONSIST OF DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE, MODERATE-TO-VIGOROUS ACTIVITY, INCLUDING RECESS.

(Over)

(B) AS APPLICABLE, A STUDENT'S PROGRAM OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM (IEP).

(C) EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SHALL DESIGNATE A PHYSICAL ACTIVITY LEADERSHIP TEAM TO PLAN AND COORDINATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACTIVITIES THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION.

(D) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION."
