AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1111
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “reducing” in line 7 down through “officer;” in line 9 and substitute “requiring an applicant for the renewal of a commission as a special police officer to receive certain training before applying for renewal;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 9, strike “A” and substitute “AN INITIAL”; in the same line, after “WHO” insert “, WITHIN 5 YEARS PRIOR TO APPLICATION,”; in the same line, after “HAS” insert “:”;

(I)”;

in line 10, after “THE” insert “SECRETARY IN CONSULTATION WITH THE”; in line 11, after “COMMISSION” insert “:”;

(II) COMPLETED A BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR POLICE OFFICERS SIMILAR TO THE COURSE DESCRIBED IN ITEM (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH IN ANOTHER STATE OR FOR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT;

(III) SEPARATED FROM A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN GOOD STANDING; OR

(IV) COMPLETED TRAINING APPROVED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION FOR A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER AT A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION”;

in line 12, strike “A” and substitute “AN INITIAL”; in the same line, after “COMPLETE” insert “A TRAINING COURSE APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION CONSISTING OF AT LEAST”; in line 13, strike “TRAINING AND EDUCATION” and substitute “INSTRUCTION, INCLUDING INSTRUCTION ON:

(I) CRIMINAL LAW;

(II) CONSTITUTIONAL PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO SEARCH, SEIZURE, AND ARREST; AND

(III) THE APPROPRIATE USE OF FORCE”;

in line 15, strike “1 YEAR”; in lines 15 and 17, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 17, strike “ANNUALLY”; in the same line, after “if” insert “:

(I) BEFORE SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL, THE SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER HAS COMPLETED 12 HOURS OF IN-SERVICE TRAINING APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION; AND

(II)”;

and in lines 19, 21, 23, and 25, strike “(i)”, “(ii)”, “(iii)”, and “(iv)”, respectively, and substitute “1.”, “2.”, “3.”, and “4.”, respectively.
