AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 784
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Maryland Online”; in the same line, strike “Act” and substitute “– Online Privacy – Study”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “information” in line 31 and substitute “requiring the Maryland Cybersecurity Council to review certain practices and methods of collection, use, storage, and disclosure of consumers’ personally identifiable information and personal information by certain entities; requiring the Council to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to consumer online privacy”.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 6, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 8, strike “the Laws of Maryland read as follows:” and substitute “, on or before November 1, 2020, the Maryland Cybersecurity Council shall:

(1) review current practices and methods of collection, use, storage, and disclosure of consumers’ personally identifiable information and personal information by private entities in the State; and

(2) submit a report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on its findings and recommendations for providing increased consumer protection regarding online privacy.”.

On pages 2 through 19, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 9 on page 2 through line 2 on page 19, inclusive.

On page 19, in line 4, strike “January 1, 2021” and substitute “June 1, 2020”.
