A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Public Schools - Student Health - Certificate of Dental Health

- FOR the purpose of requiring, beginning in a certain school year, certain students to submit a certificate of dental health to their school on a certain schedule; requiring the State Department of Education, in consultation with the Maryland Department of Health, to adopt certain regulations and to develop and disseminate a certain form to county boards of education and certain parents and guardians; and generally relating to public schools and a certificate of dental health.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) BEGINNING IN THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH STUDENT
- 19 ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE STATE SHALL
- 20 SUBMIT TO THE SCHOOL A CERTIFICATE OF DENTAL HEALTH ON A SCHEDULE
- 21 ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

- 1 (1) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF 2 HEALTH, ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH:
- 3 (I) STANDARDS FOR PERIODIC DENTAL EXAMINATIONS; AND
- 4 (II) A SCHEDULE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A CERTIFICATE OF 5 DENTAL HEALTH BY STUDENTS; AND
- 6 (2) DEVELOP AND DISSEMINATE A STANDARD FORM FOR A
 7 CERTIFICATE OF DENTAL HEALTH AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
 8 SECTION TO THE COUNTY BOARDS AND THE PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS
 9 IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
