## 2 Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Business Records

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Harford County to give a license holder a certain notice before the Board may examine the business records of the license holder; requiring the Board to make an appointment with the license holder to carry out the examination; authorizing the license holder to keep business records in a certain manner; and generally relating to business records of an alcoholic beverages license holder in Harford County.

2 (A) IF THE BOARD INTENDS TO EXAMINE THE BUSINESS RECORDS OF A 3 LICENSE HOLDER, THE BOARD SHALL:

4 (1) GIVE THE LICENSE HOLDER AT LEAST 5 DAYS' NOTICE OF ITS 5 INTENT; AND

- 6 (2) MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE LICENSE HOLDER TO CARRY 7 OUT THE EXAMINATION.
- 8 (B) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY KEEP BUSINESS RECORDS:
- 9 (1) IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT THAT THE BOARD APPROVES; AND
- 10 (2) AT A LOCATION AWAY FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2020.
